

DISASTER SUPPLY CHECKLIST

Take photographs of the inside/outside of your house and all contents, have phone number available to file insurance claim, and keep all evacuation receipts and mileage.



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General

- ☐ Two week minimum supply of medication, regularly used medical supplies, and a list of allergies
- ☐ A list of the style, serial number, and manufacturer information of required medical devices
- ☐ Flashlights & extra batteries (One per family member)
- ☐ Personal hygiene items (Toothbrush/paste, TP, deodorant)
- ☐ NOAA Radio and local maps (Battery operated or hand crank)
- ☐ Cash (At least \$300-\$500 in various increments and bills)
- ☐ Cell Phone Chargers (Power banks to go with them)
- ☐ Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children
- ☐ Generator, tools and extra fuel
- ☐ Baby diapers and formula
- ☐ Extra glasses or contacts
- ☐ Fire extinguisher, matches and duct tape
- ☐ Cooler for food and drinks

Clothing

- ☐ Rain gear such as rain jackets, umbrellas, and rain boots
- ☐ Sturdy shoes for infants, small children, the elderly, and family members with disabilities

First Aid

- ☐ First Aid Kit (With a First Aid Manual)
- ☐ Sterile adhesive bandages of different sizes
- ☐ Sterile gloves (non latex)
- ☐ Pain relievers (Ibuprofen or Tylenol)
- ☐ Scissors and tweezers
- ☐ Disinfectant wipes
- ☐ Hand sanitizer
- ☐ Thermometer
- ☐ Sterile gauze pads
- ☐ Hypoallergenic adhesive tape
- ☐ Anti-diarrheal medicine
- ☐ Q-tips

Food and Water

- ☐ **Food**
Nonperishable packaged or canned food and beverages, snack foods, juices, baby food, and any special dietary items to last at least 7 days
- ☐ **Water**
1 gallon per person, per day
- ☐ Non electric can opener
- ☐ Paper plates and paper cups
- ☐ Plastic utensils
- ☐ Napkins and wet wipes

Important Documents

- ☐ Insurance Cards
- ☐ Medical Records
- ☐ Banking Information
- ☐ Credit Card Numbers
- ☐ Copy of Social Security Cards
- ☐ Copy of birth and/or marriage certificates
- ☐ Set of car, house, and office keys
- ☐ Service animal I.D., vet records, and proof of ownership
- ☐ Information about where you receive medication, the name of the drug, and dosage
- ☐ Copy of will

*Items should be kept in a water proof and flame retardant container

Vehicle

- ☐ Keep your vehicle tanks filled with fuel at all times, especially days prior to an expected storm or event

Pet Care Items

- ☐ Pet food and water to last at least 7 days
- ☐ Proper identification
- ☐ Medical records/microchip info
- ☐ All pet medications
- ☐ Collar and leash
- ☐ Any supplies for a service pet
